

# CASWELL TROPHY



The Caswell Trophy, a French bronze miniature of the ancient statue "Winged Victory", was donated in 1923 by Colonel John Caswell, internationally famous sportsman, author and soldier for presentation at the NRA National Matches, Camp Perry, OH.

## Match Conditions:

Open to: Teams of six firing members, captain and coach. One team from the National Guard of each State, one team of Civilians from each State, one team from each branch of the Service and one CMTC and ROTC Team from Each Corps Area.

Course of Fire. Dewar Course, metallic sights, any .22 caliber rimfire rifle.

## Changes in Eligibility Conditions

- 1929 ORC and the American Legion permitted to enter teams.
- 1937 Naval Militia of each State, each Reserve National Match Team and each American Legion National Match Team also permitted to enter this match.
- 1939 One of more teams of six firing members, one alternate, a team captain and coach from the National Guard of each State, the civilians of each State and one team from each American Legion Department.
- 1952 One team consisting of a team captain, team coach, six firing members, one alternate from the following: Each State, Territory and the District of Columbia. (Previous team representation will not affect a competitor's eligibility in this match.)
- 1966 One team consisting of a team captain, team coach, four firing members, one alternate over the four position course, any sights match.
- 1978 One team consisting of a team captain, team coach, four firing members, and one alternate the NRA 3-Position any sight (20 shots per position) 50 meter course.
