

JUSTIN HURST MEMORIAL TROPHY



The Justin Hurst Memorial Trophy was sponsored by the Texas State Rifle Association and the Dallas Arms Collectors' Association, in memory of Texas Conservation Officer Justin Hurst. Game Warden Hurst, who served with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department, lost his life in the line of duty on March 17, 2007.

This perpetual trophy shows national recognition by the NRA of our conservation officers and recognizes the sacrifices that they make.

This trophy is a large bronze eagle mounted on a dark Mahogany base. A framed photograph of the trophy with engraved plaque is awarded to the High Scoring Conservation Officer in the NRA National Police Shooting Championships.

Match Conditions:

2008 Awarded to the High Conservation Officer competing in the NRA Special Grand Aggregate, consisting of the Individual Service Pistol Match, the President's Match, the NRA Police Shotgun Match and the Open Class Revolver and Semi-Automatic Handgun Aggregate match, in the NRA's annual National Police Shooting Championships.
